The Alexandra Suite is now back in full operation and busier than ever before.

Saturday's are fully booked in advance right through to February.

The vaccination campaign moved from this venue to St Mary's Church at the start of September, meaning the facility was a vaccine hub for nine months in total. During this time around 100,000 jabs were administered.

By offering this site in Swanley, hundreds if not thousands of

lives have surely been saved and pressure on local hospitals greatly reduced.

The Olympic has enjoyed a bumper summer! Swanley Rugby Club now regularly use the bar as their clubhouse.

The club recently invested £14,000 into renovating the Civic Centre's changing rooms.

Elsewhere at The Olympic, the Noypichef is continuing to be the huge success story of 2021.

His talent and desire to produce only the best quality service, has allowed the business to grow and customers simply cannot get enough of his dishes!

Food is now served inside The Olympic, with the takeaway service complimenting this.

At the back of the site, work has begun on converting the disused golf driving range into a rugby facility at the back of the venue.

Swanley Park has had another busy season, which is now drawing to a close. However, this year will see the Cafe remain open throughout the winter due to popular demand and the newly launched Soft Play Centre named The Barnyard.

Work has begun on improving the paths around the park, which will help improve the inclusivity of the amenity.

The events calendar at the park has once again proved popular. 1812 was a fabulous event, and it was great to see the community come out in force to support this free event.

The town itself was once again dressed in an award winning floral display.

In fact, Swanley Town Council received a record breaking collection of awards!

Three golds, one silver gilt and one bronze award was a fantastic achievement.

This compliments the three Green Flag park awards which have been received.

In addition, Swanley has also become the first Council in the United Kingdom to be awarded the coveted Disability Confident Leader accolade.

The competition assesses town council land for its management, appearance and community usage. This year the Town Council entered five categories.

Overall, our town was awarded with a 'Silver Gilt' – the second highest award the competition gives. Swanley Recreation Ground was called out as a gold 'category winner', and Swanley Park and Swanley Nature Reserve also were awarded the top gold award.

The maintenance of St Mary's Churchyard, which the Town Council support, was also awarded a bronze award.

This is located in Swanley Park. It is well worth a visit if you have not yet been.

Barclays Swanley Update

Swanley Town Council has held discussions with both Barclays and Kent County Councillor Perry Cole, following the disappointing announcement that the Swanley Barclays Branch will be closing on Thursday 4 November 2021.

In these meetings we expressed our regret at the decision made, and outlined our concern for customers who are dependent on the local branch.

Swanley Town Council and Cllr Perry Cole asked for a number of key concessions to be made by Barclays to help smooth the transaction for users.

Barclays have committed to having a staffing presence at the Swanley Link for up to eight weeks after the closure of the branch.

This will help guide customers to bank at the Post Office desk within the building.

Barclays are also hoping to host a 'Fraud Awareness' event during this period which will be free to attend.

All customers can withdraw or pay in cash and check balances using their Barclays debit card and PIN at the Post Office.

Customers can also pay cheques into a Barclays account using a personalised paying-in slip and a cheque deposit envelope.

However, you will need to allow two extra working days for cheques to reach your Barclays accounts using the Post Office.

When questioned on the bank's closure, Cllr Perry Cole said "It is bitterly disappointing that this local branch will be closing.

I have been working with Swanley Town Council, and together we have managed to make sure the transitional period will be supported by familiar faces from the Barclays branch.

Obviously, we would prefer for Barclays to reverse their decision but given the circumstances I am pleased we could secure some concessions from the bank."


The Oaks Partnership Health and Well-being Event ONLINE Thursday 11th November 2021 from 19:30 to 21:00

Grant secured from KCC!

Swanley Town Council was successful in securing a grant from Kent County Council (KCC) to install a hatch in Swanley Link for Piccalilly's Café.





This will allow for food and drink to be served to the outside seating area, which will be located to the side of the building.

This makes best use of an underutilised green space.

Due to COVID-19, the Café was unable to have a takeaway service due to the location.

Therefore, Piccalilly's Café asked if Swanley Town Council could help secure a £2000 grant from KCC towards a serving hatch.

This would allow the business to operate even if restrictions came back into force.

Piccalilly's will fund the additional costs involved.

Rebecca from Piccalillys Café said "We are really excited for this to happen.

We have been wanting a serving hatch for a while now.

We are grateful that we have the chance to open an outside space, which will better serve the community."

Swanley Town Council will also continue to support the Café as it hopes to attract new customers.
