
young!) enjoying themselves.

At 14.40 the Hawker Hurricane from the Battle Of Britain Memorial flight provided a flypast over the recreation ground which was a genuine crowd pleaser".





The free Reconnect Family Bus Pass is back for Summer 2022, thanks to our local bus operators.


These passes, for use between 23rd July – 31st August 2022, are intended for families who cannot attend summer activities due to a lack of transport.

# Swanley celebrates the Queen's Platinum Jubilee



More than 70,000 Big Jubilee Lunches were held in the four UK nations over the weekend, with an estimated ten million people sitting down with neighbours to celebrate Her Majesty's momentous jubilee.

From street parties and 'Big Jubilee Lunches' happening across the UK, to London's Trooping the Colour, Service of Thanksgiving, concert and pageant, the nation and Commonwealth came together over four days to mark The Queen's 70-year reign.

In Swanley we celebrated the Platinum Jubilee in style with events held each day across the town. Afternoon tea, sandwiches and cake were served up with entertainment at The Alexandra Suite to nearly 150 people.

After which the town beacon was lit to the Queen's personal specification, which also included singing of "A Life Lived With Grace" and a piper playing "Diu Regnare". This event concluded the first day of celebrations.

On day two Swanley Village Residents' Association hosted a party on the Swanley Village Green which was filled with music, games, food and drink stalls. This event was sponsored by the Town Council.

At The Olympic, a themed karaoke night of enjoyment was had with some questionable singing!

On the Saturday, and day three of the celebrations, various areas around the town hosted 'Big Jubilee Lunches', where a good time was had by all, with drink and food consumed and good old fashioned conversation occured between neighbours and friends. Photographer Kieran Judd managed to capture the day by visiting sites across Swanley. Picnic In The Park was held during the final day of the Platinum Jubilee. 500 visitors enjoyed the fun filled day hosted at Swanley Park which was for the whole family.

The day consisted of entertainment, games, children's races and food and drink stalls. Not content with finishing the celebrations too early, a themed quiz was also held at The Olympic which rounded off the four day tribute. The Mayor of Swanley, Cllr Dyball said "Each community event for the Jubilee has been fantastic, and the whole weekend as a collective was absolutely incredible.

It has been a privilege for Swanley to acknowledge our Monarch's Platinum Jubilee in such a spectacular way."

Membership is £4.00 per week to cover costs but your first week is free so it is well worth popping along to say hello!



# Owner of local home care company completes cycle for Dementia challenge
