Hybrid Application for the phased redevelopment of part of the Swanley Square Shopping Centre and land to rear, comprising a detailed application for Blocks 1,2 and 4 and an outline only application (with details relating to appearance and landscaping reserved) for Blocks 3, 5, 6, 7)

Blocks 1, 2 and 4 comprise the erection of three buildings ranging between 3 and 13 storeys in height comprising 247 residential units (9 build to rent and market), 1,457sqm of retail/commercial floorspace (use class A1-A5, B1) a multistorey car park and associated public realm surface level parking, landscaping and access works.
