Cannon fire rang through the air at regular intervals as Nothe Fort Re-enactors from Weymouth put on displays of military drills and yelled warnings to 'cover your ears'.

In addition, the Lord Lt of Kent Mrs R Dymond attended and inspected cadets taking part in a Drum Head Service Parade accompanied by the Mayor of Swanley Councillor Laurence Ball and the Leader of Sevenoaks District Council, Councillor Lawrence Abraham.

Throughout the day people could enjoy displays, food and drink and listen to music.

Vintage and classic vehicles added another element to the show while young and old enjoyed a fun packed day and said thank you to the men and women of our armed forces.

Organiser and Civic Manager Mrs Toni Roast said 'it was a great day and I am very pleased with the turnout and will be looking to double the size of the event for 2018'.

The event was supported with funding from the National Lottery and Ministry of Defence along with Kent County Council and many local sports clubs and volunteer groups also attended.

There are attempts to get an aerial display organised for next year and bookings are already being taken for available pitches.





A word from Steve Nash - CEO

I have been in post for 6 months now and have very much enjoyed the challenges of being in a new area and taking on new responsibilities. There is a great community spirit in the town and I am eager to work with local groups and organisations to help provide more opportunities for local people and I know I am supported in this by our councillors. For the first time in 30 years the Town Council has taken over the operation of Swanley Park Activities such as the boats and bouncy castle and wet areas. We have added new activities to this including: mini boats, survival parties and archery and we will continue to provide additional entertainment throughout the holidays with balloon modelling, face painting, live music and sports.

Swanley got its first Football Team last year and this year I am very pleased to say the town now has its first Rugby Team along with its very own pitch and storage area. They are now looking for a club house so keep watching how things develop.

While residents and community organisations are vitally important for the vibrancy of any town, so is local business and with councillor support I hope to support some new initiatives. We have recently set up a Swanley Chamber of Commerce with the help of Sevenoaks Chamber of Commerce and I hope that within the not too distant future it will be a completely independent organisation. Having gone through some changes ourselves we now have spare office space and I am hoping to create a Business Hub in this empty space where micro businesses can hire space for drop in or long term. More details will come out on this as we get closer to actual provision.

While the town has lost an impressive building as the Woodlands is set to be sold, the revenue this will generate for the town will allow us to do even more to support local residents and improve facilities. I hope we are demonstrating our activities in a fair and transparent way and I welcome questions about our plans for the future and our current strategy.

I look forward to meeting more of our Swanley residents as I spend more time here.



Knit one; purl one for our poppy project LEGION

A KNITTED poppy appeal is being launched for a Remembrance Day commemoration in Swanley.

The Swanley Link is working with the Royal British Legion to create a carpet of knitted or crocheted poppies.

We are hoping for more than 7,000 that will be needed to cover an area outside the Swanley Link.

We are calling on people of Swanley to get their knitting needles out and get knitting for this worthy community project.

Swanley Link Manager Claire Cormack, said: "This is such a lovely idea and one which we hope people will get involved in. Even if you can only make one poppy it will help towards our target of 7,000." The poppies can be any size and you can follow any pattern.

So far we have 100 poppies but we need more.

The poppies will need to be handed in by Friday 27 October ready to be launched for a Remembrance

Day commemoration in Swanley.
