Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) as amended and Part 6 of the Traffic Regulation Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following order:-

The effect of the made Order will introduce a one-way traffic and prohibition of turns on the following lengths of road in Swanley, Sevenoaks:-

STATION APPROACH - From its junction with Goldsel Road to its junction with Azalea Drive in a north westerly then south westerly direction, and a no right-hand turn movement from Azalea Drive into Station Approach (north westerly bound).

The Order was made on 20 January 2022 and its provisions will come into effect on 21 January 2022.

A full statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, a plan indicating the location and the effect and a copy of any other Orders which will be amended by the made Order may be examined at Kent Highways, Transportation & Waste, Ashford Highway Depot, Henwood Industrial Estate, Unit 4 Javelin Way, Ashford, Kent TN24 8AD by appointment booked through tro@kent.gov.uk or viewed online from 21 January 2022 at www.kent.gov.uk/highwaysconsultations

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following order;

Commencement and Citation

1. No person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle (excluding pedal cycles) to make a right-hand turn movement from Azalea Drive (north westerly bound) into Station Approach, Swanley, Sevenoaks.
2. No person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle (excluding pedal cycles) to proceed along Station Approach, Swanley from its junction with Azalea Drive to its junction with Station Approach in a north easterly direction.
3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes (in the event of an emergency), if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion or a vehicle in the service of the local authority in the course of road cleansing or gully emptying.
4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act.
5. The provisions of this Order shall prevail over the provisions of any previous order.
6. This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (The District of Sevenoaks) (Station Approach, Swanley) (Prohibition of Traffic Movements) Order 2021" ('this Order') and shall come into force on the 21st day of January 2022.
