NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(PUBLIC FOOTPATHS SD64 (PART) AND SD97 (PART), SWANLEY)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT
MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

On 15 December 2023 the Kent County Council confirmed the above Order under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. On the 15 December 2023 the County Council also certified that the works required to bring the new route into a fit condition for public use had been completed and, accordingly, the Order has now taken effect.

The effect of that Order as confirmed is to divert the entire width of that length of Public Footpath numbered SD64, which commences at NGR TQ 5307 6981 (Point A) and runs in a south southeasterly direction for 95 metres, then continues in a southerly direction for 27 metres to NGR TQ 5312 6969 (Point B). As shown by the bold line between Points A – B on the Order Plan and will add a new length of Public Footpath numbered SD64 with a width of 2 metres, which commences at NGR TQ 5307 5981 (Point A) and runs in an east southeasterly direction for 9 metres, then continues in a southeasterly direction for 20 metres, then continues in a south southeasterly direction for 78 metres, then continues in a southerly direction for 18 metres to NGR TQ 5313 6970 (Point C). As shown by the bold broken line on the Order Plan.

The above named Order will also divert the entire width of that length of Public Footpath numbered SD64, which commences at NGR TQ 5312 6969 (Point B) and runs in a westerly direction for 4.5 metres to NGR TQ 5311 6969 (Point E). As shown by the bold line between Points B – E on the Order Plan and will add a new length of Public Footpath, renumbered from SD64 to SD349 with a width of 2 metres, which commences at NGR TQ 5311 6969 (Point D) and runs in a north northwesterly direction for 2 metres to NGR TQ 5311 6969 (Point E). As shown by the bold broken line on the Order Plan. The western continuation of this length of Public Footpath is to be renumbered to SD349 until its junction with Public Footpath SD63.

The above named Order will also divert the entire width of that length of Public Footpath numbered SD97, which commences at NGR TQ 5313 6970 (Point C) and run in a southwesterly direction for 19 metres to NGR TQ 5312 6969 (Point B) and continues in a southwesterly direction for 4 metres to NGR TQ 5311 6969 (Point D). As shown by the bold line between Points C – B – D on the Order Plan and will add a new length of Public Footpath numbered SD97 with a width of 2 metres, which commences at NGR TQ 5313 6970 (Point C) and runs in a south southwesterly direction for 16 metres, then continues in a westerly direction for 5 metres, then continues in a west northwesterly direction for 4 metres, then continues in a north northwesterly direction for 2 metres to NGR TQ 5311 6969 (Point D). As shown by the bold broken line on the Order Plan.

All directions general, all distances approximate.

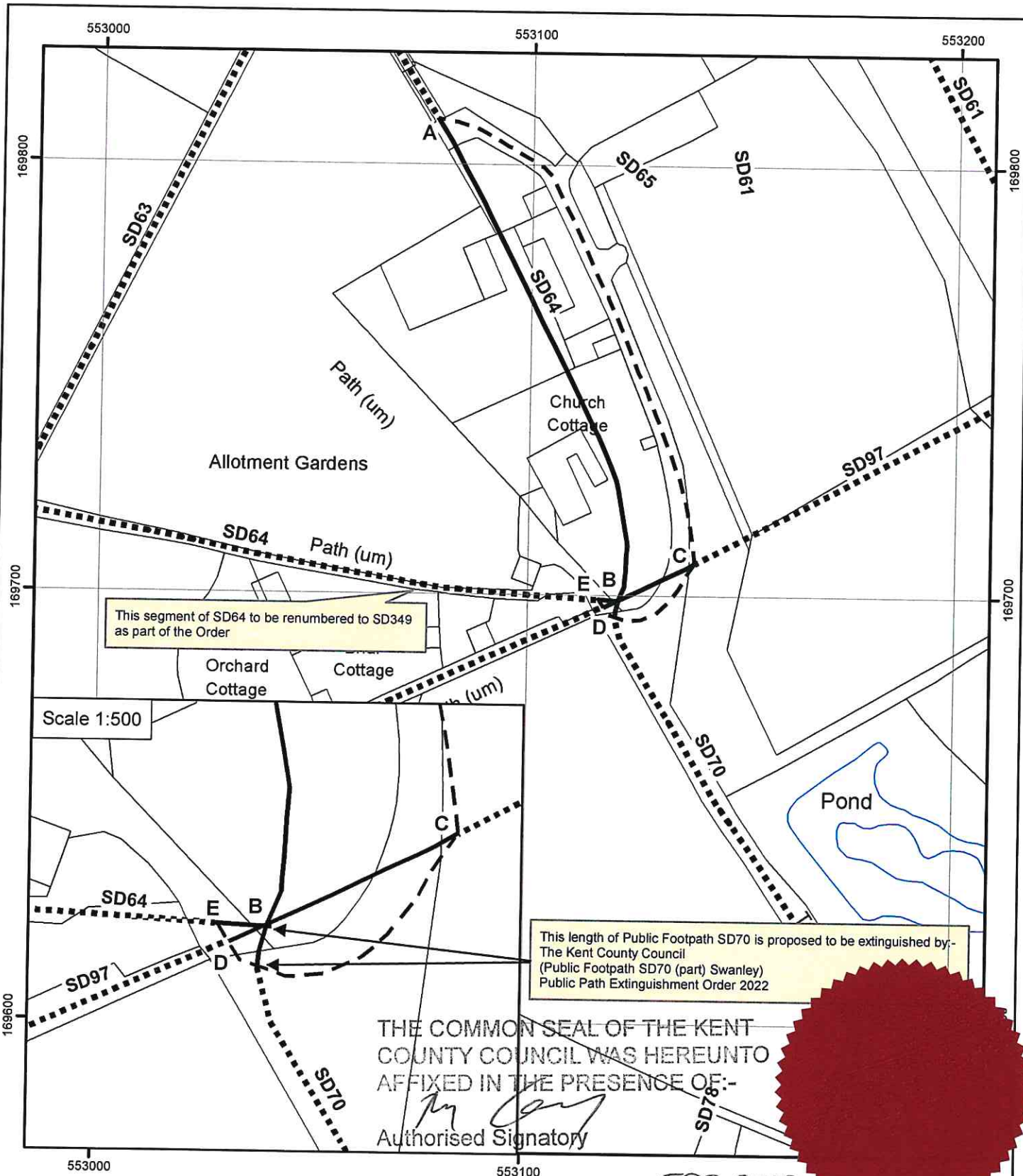

The Order comes into force on 12 January 2024, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act which has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from the 29 December 2023 make an application to the High Court.

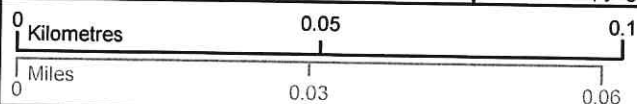

MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

This Order is made by the Kent County Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the occupier of the land crossed by the Public Footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the lines of Footpaths SD64 (part) and SD97 (part) should be diverted.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 023 (TQ56NW)) requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

The applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and pay any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the public right of way into a fit condition for use by the public.

Sevenoaks District Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act;

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Swanley and shown by bold continuous lines on the attached map contained in the Order and described in Part I of the schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order and thereupon the Definitive Map for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 023 (TQ56NW)) shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
2. The relevant date of this Order will be as specified in paragraph 1.
3. There shall be 28 days from the date of confirmation of the Order Public Footpaths over the land situate at Swanley described in Part II of the schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the Map contained in this Order, and thereupon the Definitive Map for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 023 (TQ56NW)) shall be modified by adding the paths to it.
- 3A. The Definitive Statement for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 023 (TQ56NW)) shall be modified as described in Part IV of the schedule to this Order.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part III of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART I: DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The entire width of that length of **Public Footpath SD64**, which commences at NGR TQ 5307 6981 (Point A) and runs in a generally south southeasterly direction for approximately 95 metres, then continues in a generally southerly direction for approximately 27 metres to NGR TQ 5312 6969 (Point B). As shown by the bold line between Points A – B on the Order Plan.

The entire width of that length of **Public Footpath SD64**, which commences at NGR TQ 5312 6969 (Point B) and runs in a generally westerly direction for approximately 4.5 metres to NGR TQ 5311 6969 (Point E). As shown by bold line between Points B – E on the Order Plan.

The entire width of that length of **Public Footpath SD97**, which commences at NGR TQ 5313 6970 (Point C) and runs in a generally southwesterly direction for approximately 19 metres to NGR TQ 5312 6969 (Point B) and continues in a generally southwesterly direction for approximately 4 metres to NGR TQ 5311 6969 (Point D). As shown by the bold line between Points C – B – D on the Order Plan.

PART II: DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A new length of **Public Footpath numbered SD64** with a width of 2 metres, which commences at NGR TQ 5307 6981 (Point A) and runs in a generally east-southeasterly direction for approximately 9 metres, then continues in a generally southeasterly direction for approximately 20 metres, then continues in a generally south-southeasterly direction for approximately 78 metres, then continues in a generally southerly direction for approximately 18 metres to NGR TQ 5313 6970 (Point C). As shown by the bold broken line on the Order Plan.

A new length of **Public Footpath, renumbered from SD64 to SD349** with a width of 2 metres, which commences at NGR TQ 5311 6969 (Point D) and runs in a generally north-northwesterly direction for approximately 2 metres to NGR TQ 5311 6969 (Point E). As shown by the bold broken line on the Order Plan.

The western continuation of this length of Public Footpath is to be renumbered to SD349 until it's junction with Public Footpath SD63.

A new length of **Public Footpath numbered SD97** with a width of 2 metres, which commences at NGR TQ 5313 6970 (Point C) and runs in a generally south-southwesterly direction for 16 metres, then continues in a westerly direction for approximately 5 metres, then continues in a generally west-northwesterly direction for 4 metres, then continues in a generally north-northwesterly direction for approximately 2 metres to NGR TQ 5311 6969 (Point D). As shown by the bold broken line on the Order Plan.

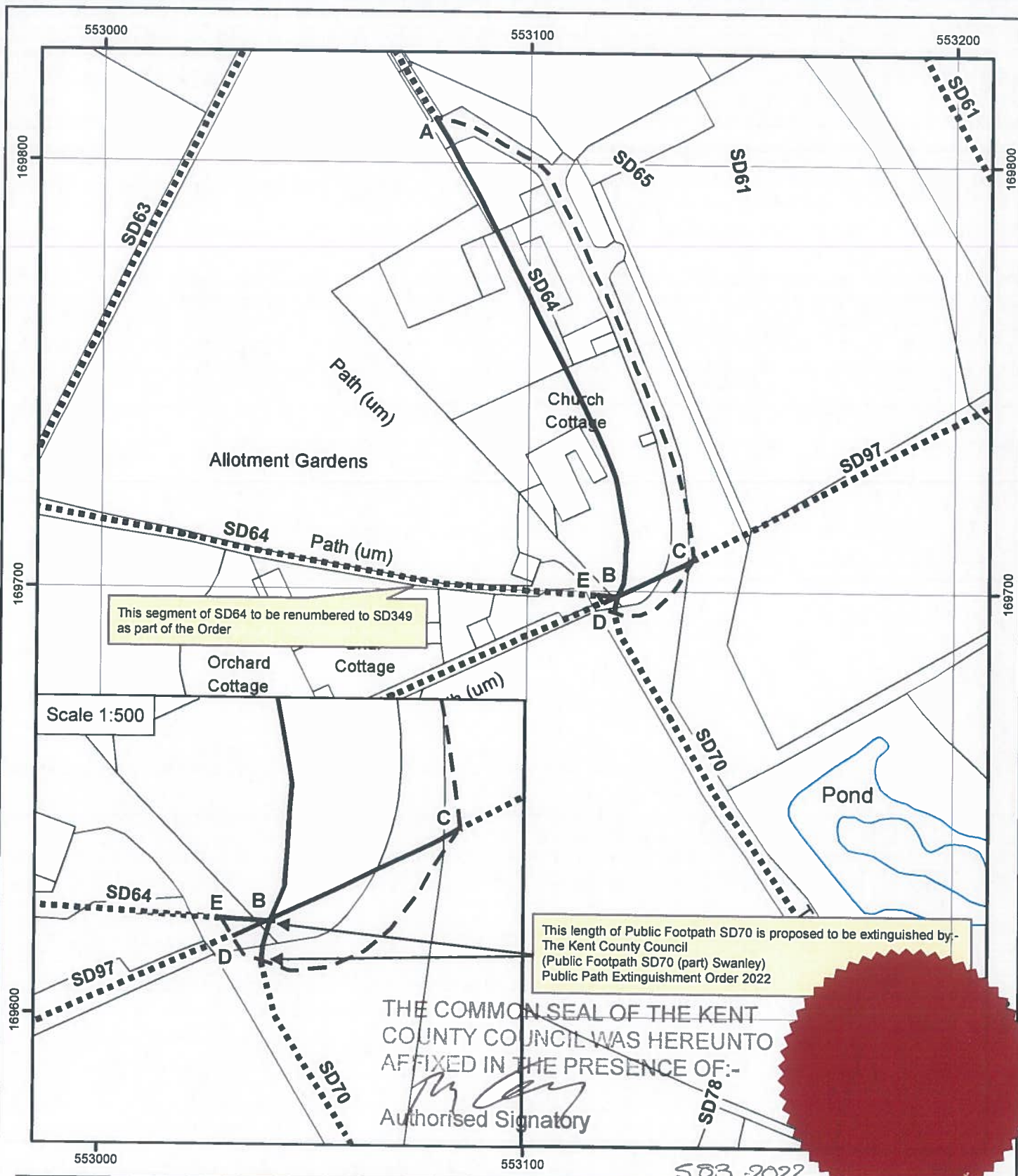

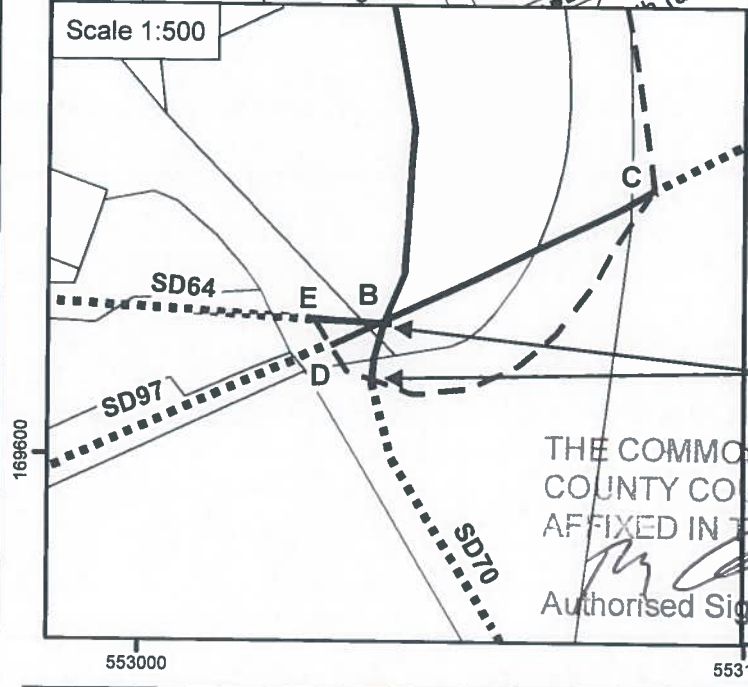

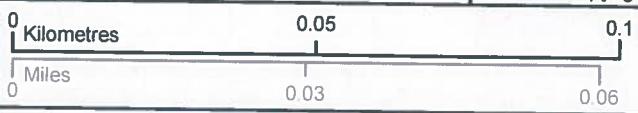
