PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT
MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

On 15 December 2023 The Kent County Council confirmed the above Order under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of that Order as confirmed is to extinguish the entire width of that length of Public footpath SD70, which commences at its junction with Public Footpath SD97 NGR TQ 5312 6969 (Point B) and runs in a south southwesterly direction for 4 metres to NGR TQ 5312 6969 (Point A). As shown between the points A – B on the Order Plan.

All directions general, all distances approximate.

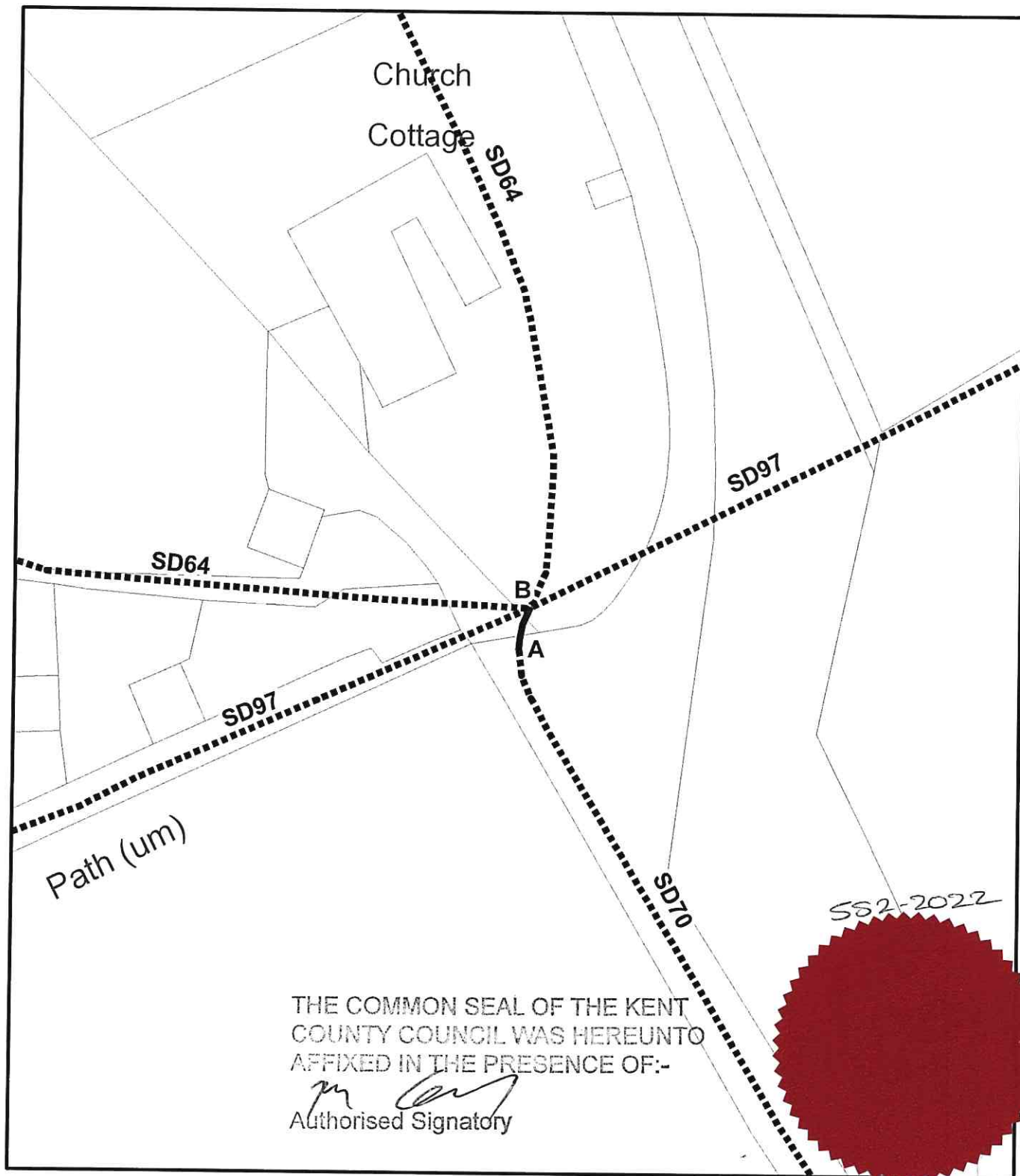

The Order comes into force on 12 January 2024, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act which has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from the 29 December 2023, make an application to the High Court.

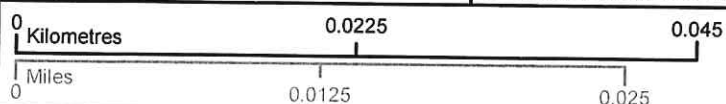

MODIFICATION ORDER 2022**

This Order is made by the Kent County Council ("the Authority") under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that the Public Footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use, and thereupon the Definitive Map and Statement (Map Sheet 023 [TQ56NW]) for the County of Kent shall be modified accordingly.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Definitive Map and Statement (Map Sheet 023 [TQ56NW]) for the County of Kent requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the stopping up (as authorised by this Order) of a highway hitherto shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Sevenoaks District Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Swanley, and shown by a continuous bold line on the attached map contained in the Order and described in the schedule to this Order shall be stopped up from the date of confirmation of this Order, and thereupon the Definitive Map for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 023 [TQ56NW]) shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
2. The relevant date of this Order will be as specified in paragraph 1.
3. The Definitive Statement for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 023 [TQ56NW]) shall be modified as described in Part II of the schedule to the Order.

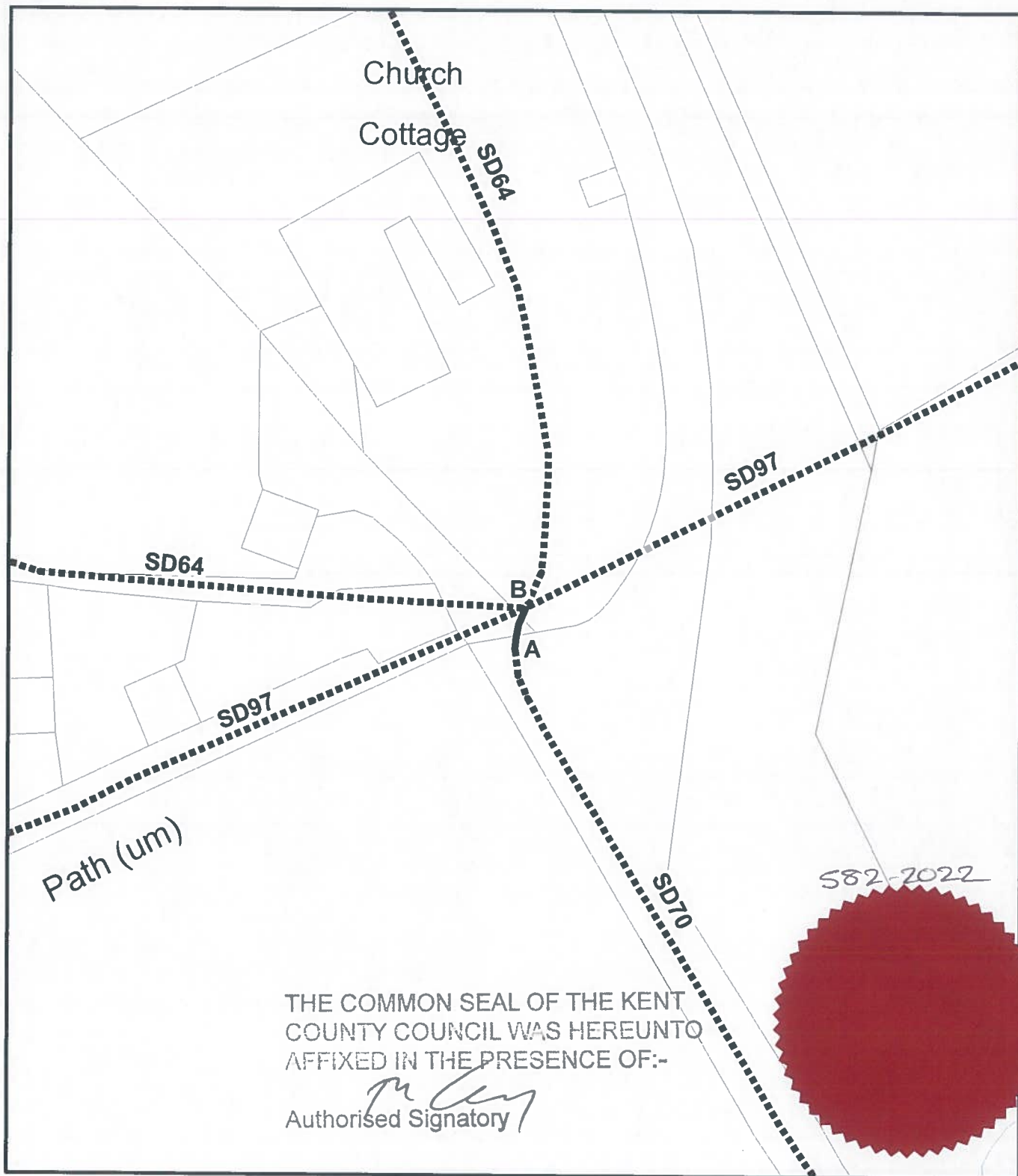

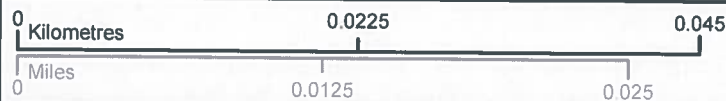
